The Arrow of Light is both a rank and an award. It is the highest achievement in Cub Scouting, and the only Cub Scout award that can still be worn once a scout enters Scouts BSA.

The seven rays of the Arrow of Light represent wisdom, courage, self-control, justice, faith, hope and love. The symbolism of the award speaks to the heart of scouting – like an arrow, scouts travel a straight path. Achieving the award is not an end, but like a new day is just a beginning. The values represented by the sun are those that form a well-rounded person. Other interpretations of the badge say that like the sun, Cub Scouts should be a light for those around them. Also, the seven rays of the sun represent the days of the week and serves as a reminder that Scouts should do their best every day.
